Our masterclass sessions offer and prioritise support to those pupils who will benefit the most from them. Although the majority of sessions will be through invite only, especially in Core subjects, there will be an opportunity for all pupils to access further support if needed.

If invited pupils do not attend for one cycle and take up this fantastic offer, their place will be offered to another pupil. Moreover, staff are volunteering their time to provide the Masterclass sessions which work best when pupils are fully engaged with the sessions, pupils not engaged will be replaced by pupils who will make the most of this offer.

Why attend?

During the sessions, teachers who are experts in their subjects and the examination process, will be creating revision resources with pupils, embedding certain elements of their course and providing strategies and resources that pupils can use independently. Pupils will acquire materials that will help with their revision and in turn will begin to improve their grade.

Within some Non-core Masterclass sessions there maybe the need for pupils to finish completing vital assignments that contribute to their coursework within those subjects.

What if I am not invited?

We do not want to exclude any pupils from these sessions. However, as there are only limited spaces at the Masterclass sessions, pupils not invited can access the Masterclass sessions through the online platform Microsoft Teams or can arrange sessions for a Friday if staff are available. Staff will also put the sessions they have completed during the Masterclass sessions onto Microsoft Teams, making the sessions accessible to all. We do endeavour to provide support to all of our pupils.

When?

Masterclass sessions will run from 2:45 until 3:45pm

There are two Masterclass timetables: a Core timetable and a Non-Core timetable which run on a three week cycle, two weeks Core followed by one week Non-Core. This is in the acknowledgement that Maths, English and Science are more important to pupils for their future destinations.
