

PE Kit Rules and Guidance

We operate a 100% kit rule, this means that all students are expected to bring their full kit to every lesson. This is made very clear to all students at the start of each year or when they newly join the school.

If students forget an item of kit they will be expected to borrow school kit from the stock we have available. Students with an injury / illness are expected to bring a note in their planner from Parents/Guardians briefly outlining the issue and what medical attention has been sought. It is essential that students still bring full PE kit in their bag as all Non-participants will be given a modified role within the department. Examples of this could include leading a small group, refereeing a match or completing focused work using just their able limbs in the Fitness Suite. This is in-line with government exercise guidance.

- We advise that gum shields and shin pads are worn for hockey.
- Football boots are advised when lessons are on the field (these can be borrowed from school).

Uniform Expectations.

All students in years 7-11 are required to wear the correct school uniform.

Any items of clothing, jewellery or hair accessories that do not adhere to the above policy may be confiscated. Parents/carers may wish to collect these items at the end of the school day.

The uniform rule is simple: wear the uniform and wear it correctly.

All clothing and personal property should be clearly marked with the student's name. All pupils are responsible for their own property. If they do not hand their valuables (e.g. jewellery, money) to their class teacher for PE, the school cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage. Items that are of considerable value should never be brought into school and the school will not accept responsibility if they are lost; this includes mobile phones.

NB: The final decision with regard to all issues relating to uniform will be made by the Headteacher.
