What will my assessment look like?
Two papers: One Non-calculator paper and one calculator paper. 90 minutes each. A mix of question styles, from short, single-mark questions to multi-step problems. The mathematical demand increases as you progress through the paper.
What do I need to revise?
You will be tested across the 6 strands of the Maths specification: 1 Number 2 Algebra 3 Ratio, proportion and rates of change 4 Geometry and measures 5 Probability 6 Statistics

What will my assessment look like?
You will complete a full paper 1. You completed paper 2 in June and paper 1 will now mean you have covered the whole exam. You will complete Q1 - 5 as a whole paper as part of your mock exams – this will enable you to have a better idea of how much time you have, how you need to split that time and to ensure you prioritise questions that are more highly weighted.
What do I need to revise?
The skills and expectations for each question. Once you have read a short piece of fiction, there are 4 related questions: Q1 – write <b>4 facts</b> about something specific from the text, as identified in the question. Q2 – Analyse a section of the text. Remember, for this one, you need to use subject terminology to <b>analyse the language</b> and reflect to the writer's intentions – what effect did they wish to create? Q3 – <b>Analyse the structure</b> of the text. Remember, for this one, you need to consider how and why the writer structured the text in the way they did. What do we learn at the beginning? How does that change as we progress through the text and how does that reflect to the writer's intentions – what effect did they wish to create at each point in the text? Q4 – <b>Evaluation</b> – To what extent do you agree with a statement given in the question. There are always 2 parts to the statement and you have to explain to what extent you agree with each part, why and what evidence there is in the text to support your evaluation. This question focuses on your ability to build a coherent argument so stay focused on the question at all times. Q5 – narrative writing: a descriptive piece or a story. You will have a picture to inspire you.

What will my assessment look like?

You will complete a half Paper 1 – with 1 extract and question based on **Romeo and Juliet**. Many of you completed a question on An Inspector Calls before the holidays and we will focus again on this and Poetry after Christmas.

What do I need to revise?

**Plot, character and timeline are a must.** You need to know what happens, in what order, who is on stage when and why. In the key scenes, think about what the characters know v what the audience knows. Revise the structure and how Shakespeare moves us from love to comedy to tragedy so seamlessly to keep the audience engaged. Revise the key themes and how these are presented.

Then consider the key scenes from the early part of the play and have a couple of key quotes up your sleeve for the main characters.

The critical thing is being able to answer a question, for example 'How does Shakespeare present the theme of responsibility in Romeo and Juliet?' and keep up a sustained, focused response. You will be expected to write around 3 sides.

What will my assessment look like?

Three exams all 75 mins long.

A mixture of multiple choice questions, structured responses, closed short answers and open responses. Questions will also include questions about the GCSE required practicals and questions that test mathematical skills.

What will my assessment look like?

Your November assessment will be based on all aspects of your coursework to this point – all work from Y10 and marks for Assessment Objectives 1, 2 and 3 for your Personal Project.

You will start your final piece for the Personal Project in exam conditions in December and complete the 10 hours by Christmas. This will complete your coursework.

What do I need to revise?

You do not need to do any revision but **everyone must** have:

- **Drawing Project** – all your drawings, all the artist sketchbook presentations and a completed A2 final piece
- **Portraiture** – a tonal portrait and/or a painted portrait, sketchbook presentations about a pattern artist, a colour artist and a drawing artist who produce portraiture

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work, your thumbnail designs, and a final A2 portrait that combines the styles of at least two of the artists studied.

- **Personal Project** – your collage and Statement of Intent, at least three copies of artists' pieces with sketchbook presentations about their work, a range of photographs relating to your theme (stuck into your sketchbook), at least three studies from photographs, experimentations and design work towards your final piece based on a mixture of the style of the artists you have looked at and your observational studies.

Some of you will also have:

- **Shoe Project** – a tonal drawing of a shoe, a copy of a Mark Schwartz shoe painting, technique samples with Brusho and/or food colouring, designs for your own shoe painting, an A2 final painting of your own shoe image in the style of Mark Shwartz.

What can I revise from?

There is nothing to revise but you do need to make sure you work at home on any outstanding work.

You must also attend Period 6 sessions on Wednesday, Thursday or Friday to help you to complete everything.
