Dear Parent/Carer

I am pleased to report that the year 11 students have made an excellent start to their examinations and despite the inevitable nerves the students' approach, maturity and attitude has been faultless.

Currently, Year 11 students have a mixture of examinations and attending their timetabled lessons. Within the majority of their subjects students still have examinations, in these lessons the class will be working on crucial exam technique in preparation for the upcoming exams in this subject.
