Blackpool Pleasure Beach Rewards Trip Wednesday 20th July 2022.

Please find below the details and final arrangements for our Y10 rewards trip to Blackpool Pleasure Beach.

All students taking part in the trip must arrive in school on Wednesday morning at 8.20am prompt, and need to register at the top of the drive with the member of staff allocated to their coach. Staff in charge will then lead them to their coach which will leave at 8.30 a.m. Students will NOT be allowed to board coaches without having registered with the member of staff first.

Students taking part in the trip need to wear school uniform polo shirt. Jeans and shorts are acceptable but must be an appropriate length. Mobile phones are also covered by our school rules of 'See it, Hear it, take it,' students may bring a mobile but it should be on silent and not being used.

Students will be issued with a wristband and an Access ticket for all rides. They will need to keep this safe as if it is lost they will be unable to access any rides. The tickets we have entitles them to go on all of the rides, but the Theme Park is cashless and all outlets (including food) only accept cards.

If the weather is warm, we recommend your child brings and uses appropriate sun cream. Water and a hat are useful too.

We intend to leave Blackpool Pleasure Beach at 2.45pm and expect to return to school at about 5pm (traffic permitting). We ask if you are collecting your young person to not park too near to the top of drive, otherwise it will delay the coaches as they arrive back.

If your child struggles with travel sickness, please encourage them to eat and drink sensibly prior to travelling on the coach and to notify the members of staff on board, should they begin to feel unwell. Please urge them not to leave it until it is too late.
