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Student Leadership Agreement

Leadership Role: Student Leaders acknowledge the responsibilities associated with their leadership role and agree to act as positive role models for their peers. Academic Excellence: Student Leaders commit to excelling in all of their subjects and have a positive ratio of stamps on ClassCharts and excellent attendance. Students encourage their peers to excel academically and personally.

Community Engagement: Student Leaders will actively participate in and support community events, service projects, and initiatives that contribute to the Trust community.

Communication: Student Leaders agree to maintain open and effective communication with both SLT and fellow students, fostering an atmosphere of transparency and trust. The first contact for student leaders is Mr Ickringill, the Associate Assistant Head for Enrichment and Student Leadership for Personal Development.

Professional conduct: Student Leaders will conduct themselves in a professional manner, demonstrating respect for all members of the school community and represent the school positively in all interactions. Student leaders will follow the 7 simple rules at all times, these are:

1. Treat all others with respect.
2. Be punctual to school and lessons.
3. Be equipped for success.
4. Wear the full and correct uniform, including PE kit.
5. No mobile phones to be seen or heard whilst on school premises.
6. No eating/ drinking in the classrooms or on the corridors (except water).
7. Transition through school in a safe and sensible manner and maintain excellent standards of behaviour at break and lunch.

Failure to meet the expectations agreed to in this contract can result in the removal of Student Leader status at the discretion of Mr Ickringill and Mr Ray.
